

TODAY'S PROMISE

TODAY'S THOUGHT

TODAY'S THOUGHT

You do not know what the year ahead will bring, but if the Lord determines your steps and you are following where he leads, you can be sure that your life will have purpose. In addition, when you keep your eyes on the goal, you will not stray from God, regardless of what difficulties you encounter.

DECISIONS

TODAY'S PROMISE

TODAY'S THOUGHT

Despite the fact that change is a certainty in the world around you, you can always be truly secure about two things: First, when you make decisions and live each day based on the changeless truths of God's Word, you have complete assurance that you are doing the right thing. Second, when you have made the decision to follow Christ, who died and rose to give you new life, you can be absolutely sure that your eternal future with him in heaven is secure.

JANUARY 6

AFFIRMATION

TODAY'S PROMISE

God created human beings in his own image. In the image of God he created them; male and female he created them.

—GENESIS 1:27

TODAY'S THOUGHT

When God created you, he affirmed you. He created you for a specific reason and purpose: to reflect his glory and characteristics. When you struggle with discouragement, remember how you have been created in God's likeness.

TODAY'S PLAN

Spend some time thinking about the qualities of God. You have many of these same qualities. Will you reflect them toward others?

GUIDANCE

TODAY'S PROMISE

TODAY'S THOUGHT

God's guidance is less like a searchlight, which brightens a wide area, and more like a flashlight, which illuminates just enough of the path ahead to show you where to take the next few steps. God has a definite plan for you. Never doubt that.

But he usually doesn't reveal it all at once. He wants you to learn to trust him each step of the way.
